1 Kings 14:1-20

1. Verses 1-20 are the inevitable outworking of 13:34. What was the sin of the house of Jeroboam?
2. In verse 10 God uses very strong language to describe what he will do with Jeroboam. Basically God calls Jeroboam a pile of dung! How do you reconcile this with a God of love?
3. Verses 7&8 list some of the ways in which God has been good to Jeroboam. So why was he and why are we so often oblivious to the good God has brought into our lives?
4. David is described as one who followed God with all his heart doing only what was right (v8). How do we reconcile this with what we know of David's life?
5. In Abijah God has found something good (v13) yet he is to die. Starting with Isaiah 57:1&2 formulate an understanding of what is going on here.
