1. The words that bring into being the “Lord’s Supper” are preceded by the prediction of Judas’ betrayal and followed by the prediction of Peter’s betrayal. What theological point is being made by placing these two predictions next to Jesus’ words of institution?
2. Does the Lord’s Supper make perfect sense or not without a working knowledge of the Passover?
3. We know how frequently the Passover was to be celebrated. How frequently should the Lord’s Supper be celebrated?
4. If you were conducting a communion service how would you open up v22 & 24?
5. What was your most memorable communion?
6. Why do some denominations insist that only clergy may lead at the table?
7. What is it about eating and drinking that ‘connects’ us to Jesus’ death?
